



## HP Security Field Update:

December, 2023

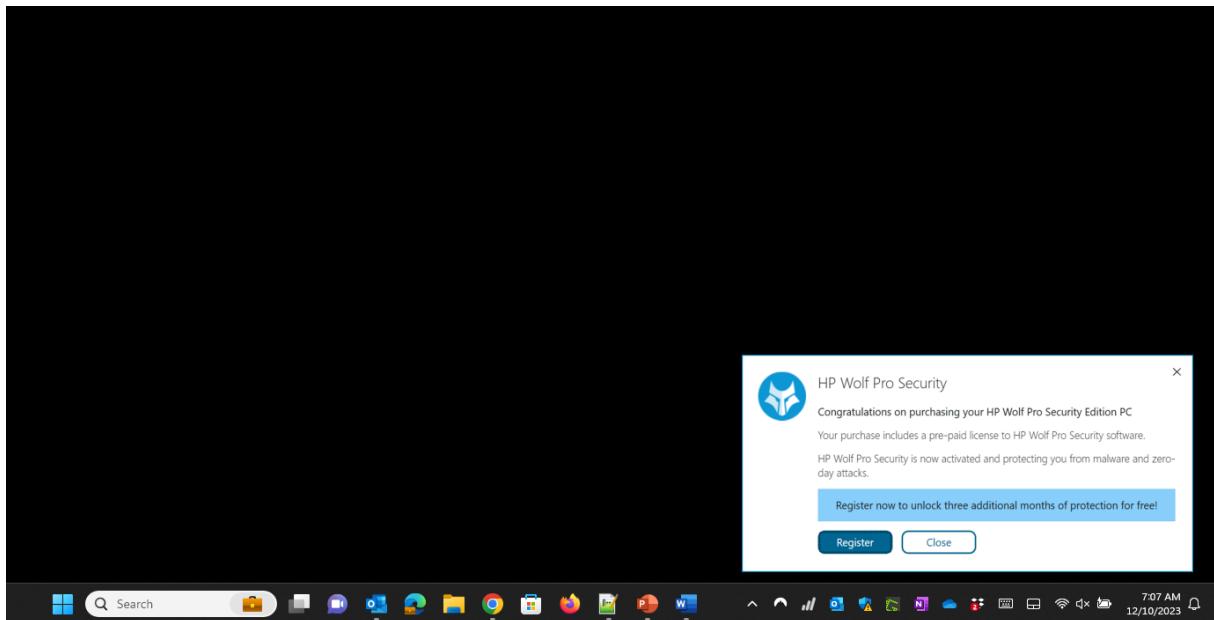
Scope : This document includes updates and bug fixes for Wolf Pro Security/Edition.

**Availability:** Endpoint rollout starting **Dec 22, 2023** (through January)

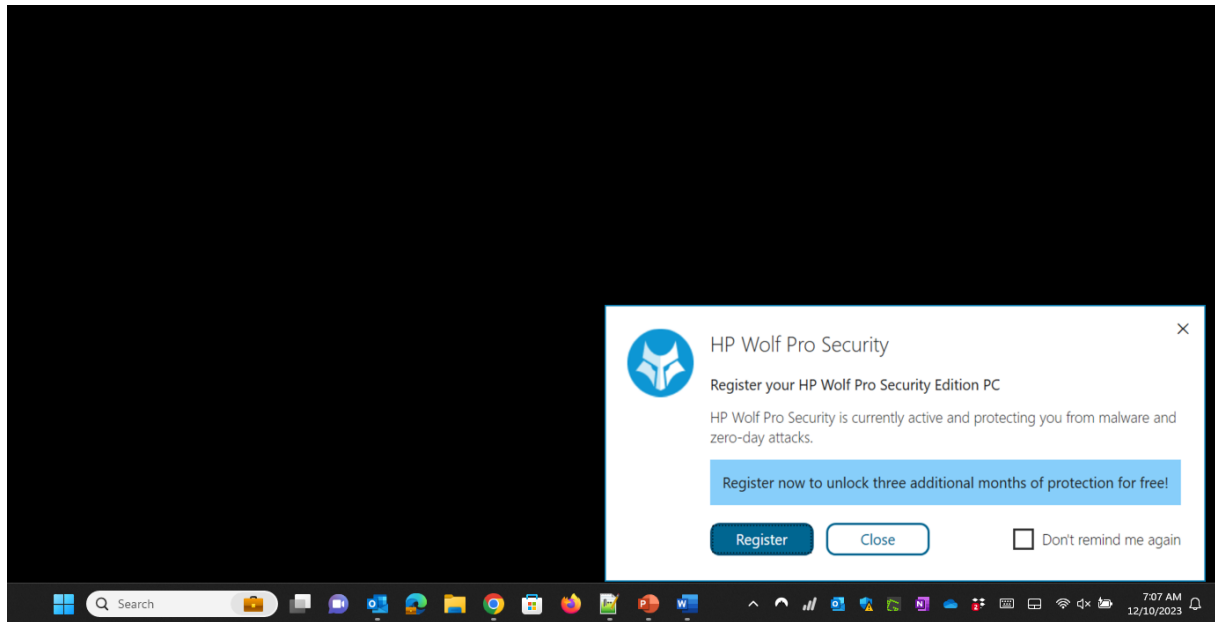
**Version:** 4.4.11

- **New Registration alerts and “3 free months” license extension offer.**

Newly activated Wolf Pro Security Edition (WPSE) PCs will show a pop-up reminding end users to register the software license. The registration pop-up will also offer **3 free months** of additional software use to help entice end users to register.



Registration reminder pop-ups will show up every 5 days after the device is active devices until the software has been registered.



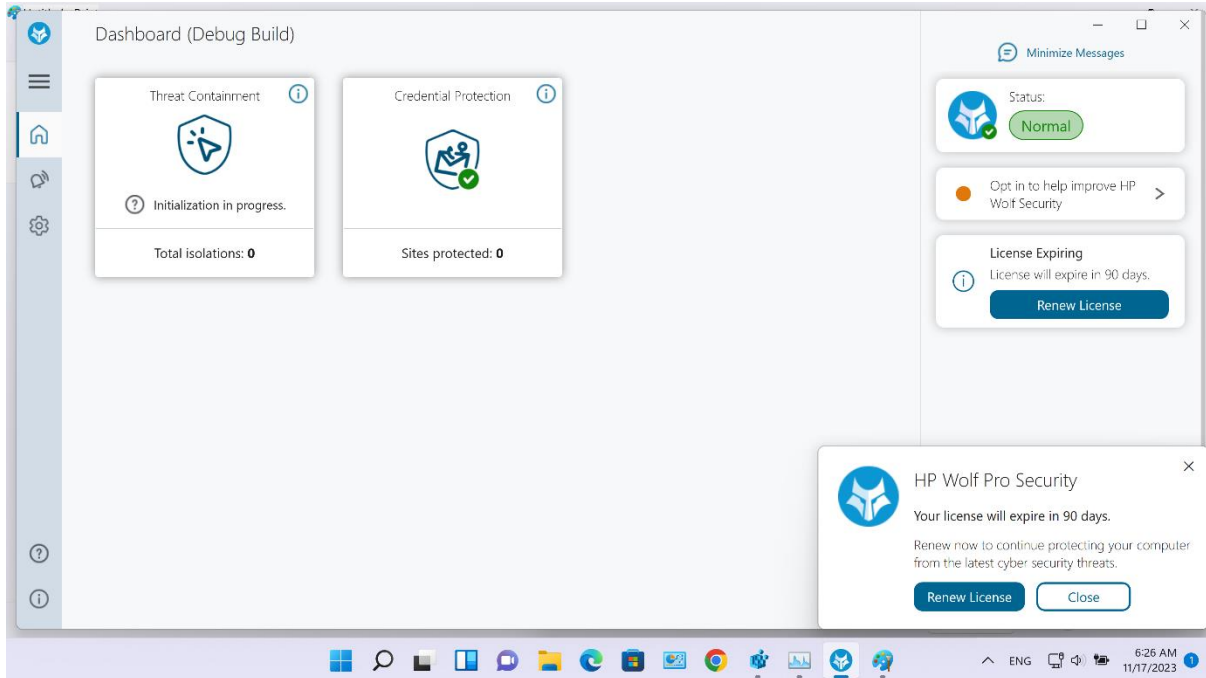
The 'Don't remind me again' option will only appear after the popup has been closed three times without registration.

If the endpoint is within 90 days of license expiry the registration pop-up will be replaced by the renewal reminder message.

- **New cadence for renewal reminder messages**

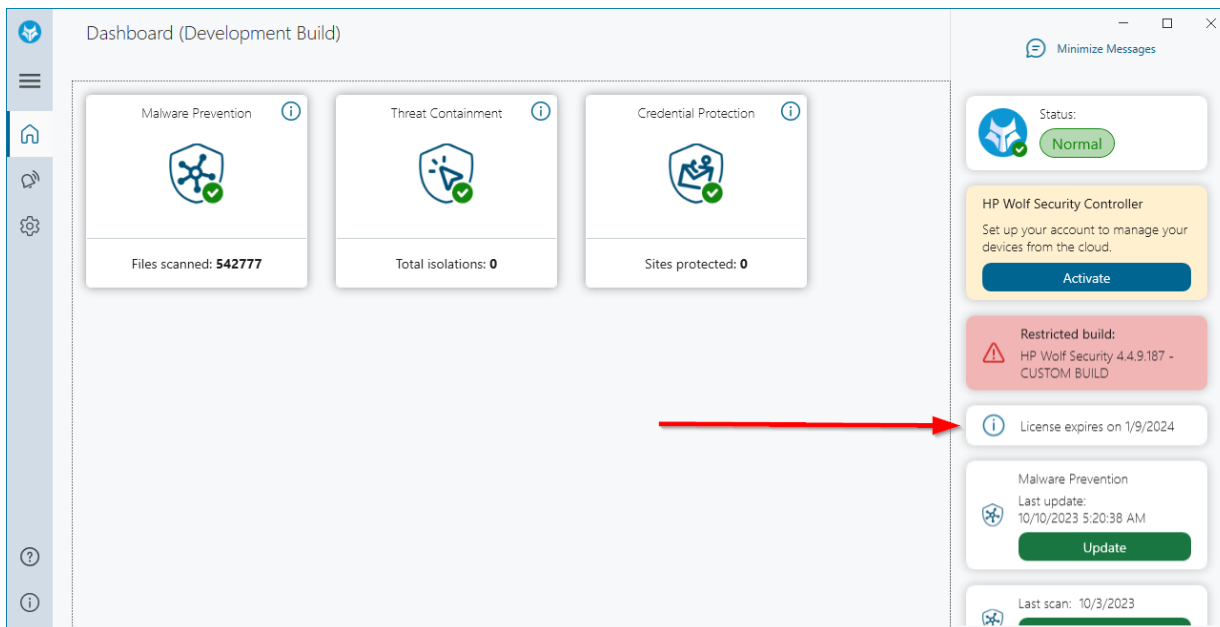
License renewal reminders will pop-up with increased frequency. Renewal reminders will now show up on the following days *before* the expiry date and the start of the grace period. License renewal Grace Period starts at day -1 and last for 30 days.

- Before the expiration date: 90, 60, 30, 15, 7, 1, 0 days
- License Renewal Grace Period: Every 5 days
- After the grace period (product is disabled): every day until renewed



- **License expiry date always visible on the desktop console**

The license expiry date will always be visible on the desktop console in the messages section.



This message will switch to showing renewal reminder messages once there are 90 days remaining on the license.

- **A reboot is no longer required when WPS is configured to be the system Anti-virus (AV).**

A reboot will no longer be required when WPS becomes the system AV. Before version 4.4.11, newly activated WPS licenses on WPSE PCs required a reboot before the WPS AV would be recognized in the Windows Security Center.
